BC Resolution # 03-11-26-C

Support for the Appointment of Dan Skenandore to the Department of Veteran's Affairs Advisory Committee on Tribal and Indian Affairs

- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States of America; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Nation; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1, of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS,** the Advisory Committee on Tribal and Indian Affairs (Committee) was established in accordance with section 7002 of Public Law 116-315 (H.R.7105 – Johnny Isakson and David P. Roe, M.D. Veterans Health Care and Benefits Improvement Act of 2020); and
- WHEREAS,** the Committee provides advice and guidance to the Secretary of Veterans Affairs on all matters relating to Indian tribes, tribal organizations, Native Hawaiian organizations and Native American Veterans.; and
- WHEREAS,** the Committee serves in an advisory capacity and advises the Secretary on ways the Department can improve the programs and services of the Department to better serve Native American Veterans; and
- WHEREAS,** the Committee members make recommendations to the Secretary regarding such activities; and
- WHEREAS,** there are many Oneida members who have knowledge and connections within the Oneida Nation community and awareness of Indian Country needs; and
- WHEREAS,** Dan Skenandore serves as the Vice-Chair on the Oneida Public Safety and Security Commission, he serves as a Green Bay Police Officer, he is a veteran of the United States Army where he honorably served 3 years, and has been appointed to the Oneida Nation Veterans Affairs Committee; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee believes that Mr. Skenandore will bring local and Indian Country insights to this Committee improving the lives of all veterans; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Oneida Business Committee supports the appointment of Dan Skenandore to the Department of Veteran's Affairs Advisory Committee on Tribal and Indian Affairs.
