

2026 GENERAL ELECTION CAUCUS

Caucus Process:

- * Must be an enrolled Oneida Nation Tribal Member to participate
- * Current age for the Oneida Tribal electoral process is 18 years old
- * Announce that those who wish to nominate anyone will be asked to line up at the Microphone by order of Board, Committee and Commission. Advise if there are any elders or disabled persons that will need a microphone be brought to them to raise their hand and a microphone will be brought to them.
- * Ask those that are nominating individuals to please clearly state their name and the name of the person they are nominating as the record keeper will be keeping a running list of nominations.
- * Those being nominated must be present at nomination.

Application Process:

- ◆ Nominated individuals DO NOT fill out petition form. Individuals not nominated at the caucus wanting to be placed on the ballot will need to complete a petition.
- ◆ Applications are due to the Main Office of the Government Administrative Office, 1st Floor – NHC. Deadline is

Friday, April 17, 2026, by 4:30 pm. NO EXCEPTIONS!

- ◆ Names will be placed on the ballot based on date & time applications are received. They will be date & time stamped.
- ◆ Applications must be turned-in in person, mailed (or other delivery service) will **NOT** be accepted.
- ◆ Electronic applications will also **NOT** be accepted.
- ◆ It is the Applicants responsibility to provide required documentation – Please be sure to read the instructions page of the application.
