Alliance for Tribal Clean Energy (ATCE) Indigenous Power & Light Fund Grant Application

- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States of America; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Nation; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1, of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation supports local food sovereignty efforts; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation is currently constructing the Oneida Community Cannery; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation supports solar electric development on Tribal facilities; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation is currently managing a solar electric systems at Food Distribution and Food Pantry; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Nation supports the installation, operations, maintenance, replacement, and redevelopment of clean energy projects on Tribal facilities; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Oneida Nation Business Committee supports the grant application to the ATCE for an amount not to exceed \$500,000 (five hundred thousand dollars).

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, the Oneida Nation Business Committee supports the installation, operations, maintenance, replacement, and redevelopment of solar electric at the Oneida Community Cannery, Food Distribution, and Food Pantry.
