Temporary Lane Closures of the Ray Nitschke Memorial Bridge

The City of Green Bay's Department of Public Works is announcing upcoming temporary lane closures of the Ray Nitschke Memorial Bridge (Dousman and Main Streets) for construction activities. Motorists shall be advised that the bridge will remain open to vehicular, pedestrian, and vessel traffic with staged lane closures to vehicular traffic beginning Monday, July 13, 2026 through October 2026.

Vessel Impacts

Ray Nitschke Memorial Bridge at Mile 1.58, over the Fox River at Green Bay, Wisconsin

No impacts or change to the normal operating schedule.

Traffic Impacts

Ray Nitschke Memorial Bridge (Dousman & Main Streets over the Fox River)

Staged lane closures will begin Monday, July 13, 2026 through October 2026.

Single lane traffic and sidewalk will remain open to vehicular and pedestrian traffic throughout the duration of work.

Detour

No detour will be posted.

Access to residences and businesses will be maintained. All closures, detours, and work operations are weather dependent and subject to change. Motorists should anticipate back-ups and are encouraged to find alternate routes.
