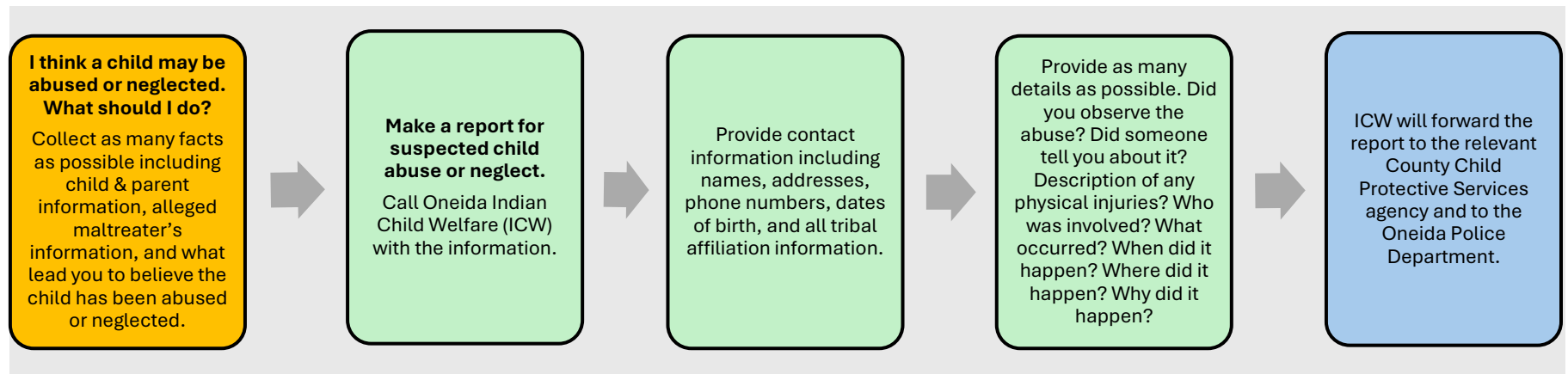




Oneida Nation Policy on Reporting Child Abuse and Neglect

Am I obligated to report? Yes.

All Tribal employees are responsible for protecting the health and welfare of the children with whom they come into contact during their employment.



After-Hours Reports: If Oneida ICW offices are closed then you should call the County Child Protective Services agency in which the child resides. **For after-hours reports you will also need to complete the Child Abuse and Neglect Reporting Form (found on the Oneida Portal aka Share Point).** Complete the form with as much information as possible and fax it to the Oneida Police Department. In the event of a life-threatening emergency, the Tribal employee shall call 911 prior to making a report.
