Required to obtain an Oneida Nation Sportsmen License

- Oneida Nation enrolled members MUST have a Driver's License or State issued ID or Oneida Nation ID.
- Spouses and Descendants MUST have a Driver's License or State issued ID and Oneida Nation Land Use Permit (Obtained from Enrollments Office) and Driver's License.
- Oneida Nation Youth Descendants and Dependents are exempt from Driver's License or State ID requirements but must obtain an Oneida Nation Land Use Permit (Obtained from Enrollments Office).
- Descendant/Dependent youth are allowed to obtain an Oneida Nation Sportsman license until age of seventeen (17) years old.
- Sportsmen born on or after 01-01-1973, MUST have valid Hunter Safety Certification number.
- Veterans can provide a Veteran ID Card for Hunter Safety Certification.
- Designated Hunter MUST have a valid Oneida Sportsman License.
