

ANNUAL ASBESTOS MANAGEMENT PLAN NOTIFICATION

NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY

To Staff, Parents/Guardians, and Students:

This notice serves to fulfill annual notification requirements in accordance with Section 763.93 of the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). AHERA requires that all school buildings be visually inspected by accredited inspectors to identify all asbestos-containing building materials (ACM) that may be present in the school environment. As required under AHERA, the Oneida Nation High School must maintain an Asbestos Management Plan (AMP) and keep the AMP on file at the school in the School Administrative Office. The AMP is available for review during school hours, Monday through Friday at ONHS Office from 8 AM through 4 PM.

Periodic surveillance of known asbestos in the Oneida Nation High School is performed every six months by a designated person to assess the condition of the ACM. Six-month Assessment Results are maintained and are also available for review in the AMP.
