

FINANCE COMMITTEE NEWS

for the FY27 ONEIDA FINANCE FUND

The Finance Committee is now taking **Oneida Finance Fund applications** for the FY2027 Fiscal Year. The purpose of this fund remains the same: to serve the Oneida community by offering funds for Oneida families. The Oneida Finance Fund is available to all Wisconsin enrolled Oneida members and is designated specifically for:

1. Self-Enrichment (for youth and adults)

The Finance Committee encourages all requesters to choose safe activities for their families. All funding requests do obligate the requester to provide a 10% match. Minors can request up to \$750.00 and up to \$250.00 for adults (18+) once per year/per person. Households with up to three (3) eligible children may receive up to \$750 per child, and one (1) eligible adult may receive up to \$250, for a maximum total of \$2,500 per household per fiscal year. Additional changes include a \$120.00 cap on all fitness-related activity requests for adults (18+). Requests for gym memberships must be submitted under an eligible adult household member.

The Finance Committee reviews requests at their first meeting of the month. The FY27 packets/forms are available on the Oneida Nation Website page under the Finance Committee. You can also contact the Finance Administration Office via their e-mail address: FAO@oneidanation.org to obtain/submit applications or to find out more information.

All requesters are asked to submit requests at fifteen business days before the conclusion of the event. Completed forms and back up information are to be *E-Mailed* to the above address in PDF format only. For those without computer access you can mail your completed application with backup information to Oneida Finance Administration Office, Attn: Oneida Finance Fund, P.O. Box 365, Oneida, WI54155.

NOTE: The Oneida Finance Fund does not review any travel or travel related requests; requests that can be obtained from another tribal program; or any type of personal request. No request will be reviewed if requester has received funding in FY2026 and has not submitted the required follow-up report. Individual requests are limited to one request per person, per fiscal year, up to \$250 for adults (18+) and up to \$750 for minors. Households with up to three (3) eligible children may receive up to \$750 per child, and one (1) eligible adult may receive up to \$250, for a maximum total of \$2,500 per household per fiscal year. Up to 50% of the requested amount may be used for equipment, uniforms, or special clothing necessary to participate in the event. All fitness-related activity requests for adults (18+) will be capped at \$120.00. **Receipts are required if seeking reimbursement and must be turned in with the application.**
